- 25 metre 8 lane heated outdoor pool
- Additional warm-up / cool-down pool
- Concession both days breakfast and lunch
- Ample space for family / team tents
- Free parking in parking lot south of the pool
- Swimmer/equipment drop-off area available on the south side of pool off Boundary Rd

#### WARM UP TIMES

- Times and lanes for warm-ups will be assigned after official entries are received and emailed to head coaches and/or club executives prior to the meet
- The warm-up/cool-down pool on the west end may also be used during the meet as long as all swimmers are supervised by their own team coach

## MEET FORMAT

- Preliminary heats and finals for all divisions, except (Div. 8, O-Cat 1 and O-Cat 2)
- Divisions 8, O-Cat 1 and O-Cat 2 will be swam as timed finals
- This is an open meet; there will be no A/B distinction
- Relays:
  - There will only be relays on Saturday. No relays Sunday.
  - Relays on Saturday will be mixed freestyle relays, each relay will need to consist of 2 boys and 2 girls
  - Alternates will need to be of the same gender as the person they are replacing
  - Swimmers can swim up divisions to allow for clubs to create enough relay teams
  - o Relays will be timed finals
- 6 & Under 25 M events:
  - Saturday (Free and Fly) and Sunday (Back and Breast)
  - Timed finals
  - Swimmers cannot be entered into the 50 M or 100 M event in the same stroke
  - o Swimmers are not eligible for disqualification
  - Candy bags will be handed out to 6 & Under participants

## **SEEDING EVENTS**

- The top three heats will be circle seeded for all preliminary rounds, the remaining heats will be rank seeded, fastest to slowest. Swimmers entered with no time (NT) will be seeded in the slowest heats
- Estimated times are acceptable for seeding but please make the times realistic
- Events during heats will be swum combining Divisions 1-3 and O-Cat 1, and Divisions 4-8 and O-Cat 2
- **FINALS**: 1<sup>st</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> will be swum **in each Division**, except for Division 8, O-Cat 1 and O-Cat 2 (which will be timed finals). **Consolation ("B") Finals** will also be swam by the 9th to 16th fastest swimmers in Divisions 1, 2, and 3 50m events only (Saturday and Sunday)

#### **ENTRIES**

- Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event
- 6 & Under event swimmers are able to swim in all four 25 M events
- Team Manager entries and full team rosters must be submitted to: meetmanager@burnabybarracudas.com
- Please submit one complete Hy-tek entry file by no later than NOON on Tuesday, June 3, 2025
- Contact email and phone number required of the individual generating entries
- Meet Entry Fees Due by 3:00 PM on Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Can be done by e-transfer (treasurer@burnabybarracudas.com) or by cheque (payable to <u>BURNABY</u>
   <u>BARRACUDAS SUMMER AQUATICS CLUB</u> and hand delivered to Joanne Tishenko Meet Manager)
- Relay slips must be submitted by 9:30 AM on Saturday to the office shed located behind the coach's tables. No relays on Sunday.

#### DECK ENTRIES

- Will be charged an additional \$20 surcharge per swimmer, per event and must be submitted in writing to the Office Shed by 7:30 AM SHARP!
- The deck entry fee MUST be paid in cash or e-transferred to treasurer@burnabybarracudas.com at the time the entry is made. No exceptions!
- Deck entries will be accepted as space and time permits without re-seeding. The Meet Manager reserves the right to refuse any deck entry

#### OFFICIALS

 All clubs are required to supply Senior Deck Officials & Stroke and Turn Officials throughout the meet. We will send out a sign-up schedule in the week leading up to the meet

- Clubs will be assigned lanes and times for timers and recorders in relation to the number of entries
- Lane assignments and times will be sent out in advance of the meet. A copy of the sign-up sheet will be available for reference by the office shed on both days of the meet
- Light snack food will be provided for all officials and volunteers on deck

#### MARSHALLING

- Division 1 3 and O-Cat 1 individual heats and finals will be marshalled
- Division 4 8 and O-Cat 2 individual heats will NOT be required to check in with the
  Clerk of the Course and will NOT be marshalled. All swimmers in this category will be
  assumed to be competing unless scratched before the start of the meet that day.
  Courtesy calls will still be made but it is the responsibility of the swimmer to ensure
  they are behind the blocks at the time of their races.
- All relays will be marshalled
- Events will be officially called by the Clerk of the Course in the marshalling area. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to be close enough to hear the Clerk call the events. All calls made by the announcer over the P.A. system are courtesy calls only.
- DURING FINALS, the Clerk of the Course shall call the swimmer's event two times with at least
  one minute between each call. If a swimmer is not present at the Clerk of Course at this time,
  they will be disqualified and an alternate will be called. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or
  alternate to be at the Clerk of the Course when the final event is called.

## RESULTS

- Results will be posted outside on the east wall of the office building, and in Meet Mobile, on the day of the meet
- Final results will be sent to the same club representatives that send in the entries once the meet is done

#### RULES

- This meet is sanctioned by BCSSA and all BCSSA rules apply
- Spectators will only be able to view from the designated spectator viewing areas.
- Spectators are not permitted on the working pool deck (which is designated by a roped off area the circumference of the pool), at the coach's tables, behind the blocks, at the electronic tables or in the marshalling area.

#### FUNDRAISING

- Electronic 50/50 draw will be available for purchase (via Visa, Master Card, debit card, & cash)

  - Draw will occur at 1 PM on Sunday, June 8, 2025 at Central Park Outdoor Pool

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- NO tenting is allowed on pathways
- NO dogs allowed on pool deck
- Only CLUB team tents will be allowed to be stored on the pool deck overnight (in the north-east corner)
- NO parking allowed on grass or field south of parking lot
- If you are parking on the residential streets around the pool, please be aware of parking bylaws (max 3 hours between 8 am and 6 pm)
